YOGA DAY “YOGA AYUSH”

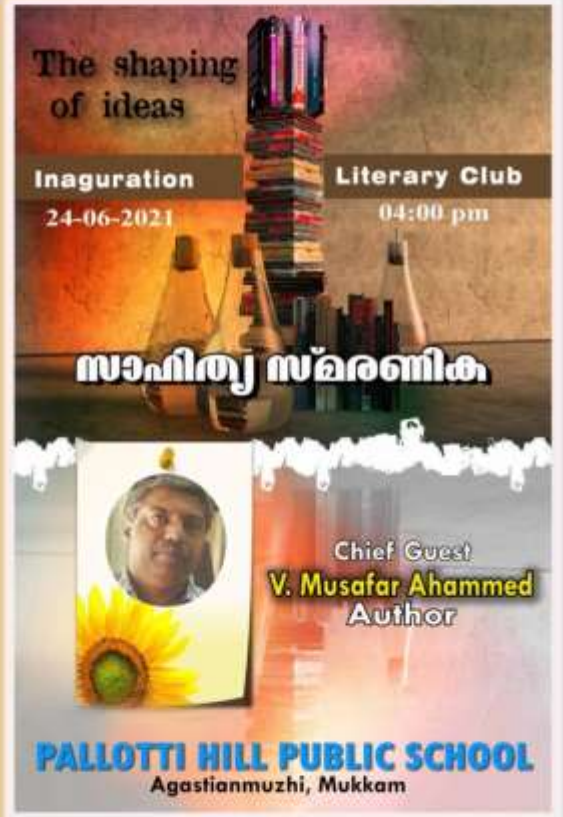

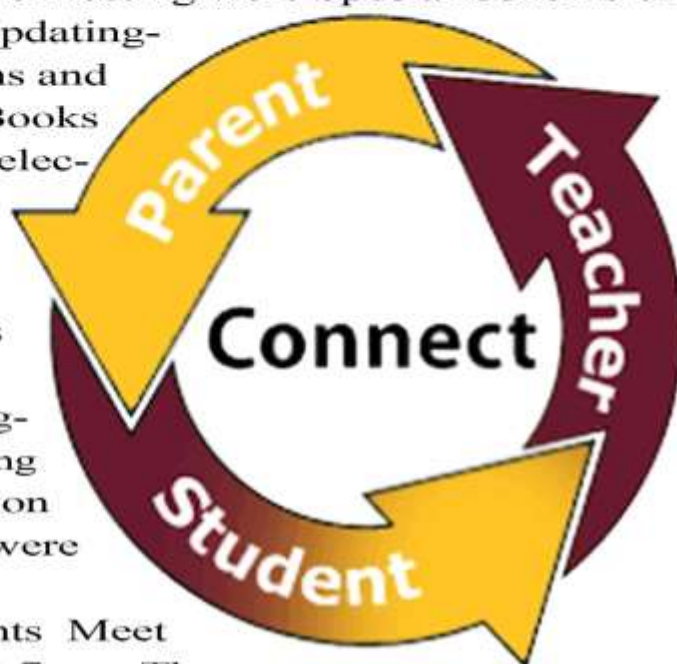


PARENTS' MEET

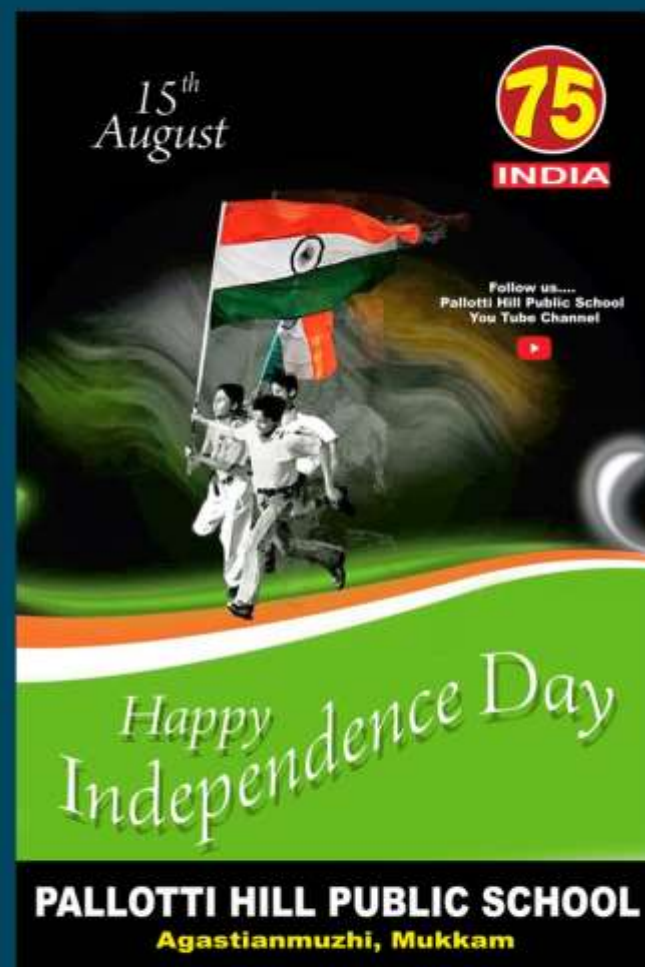
QUIT INDIA DAY
