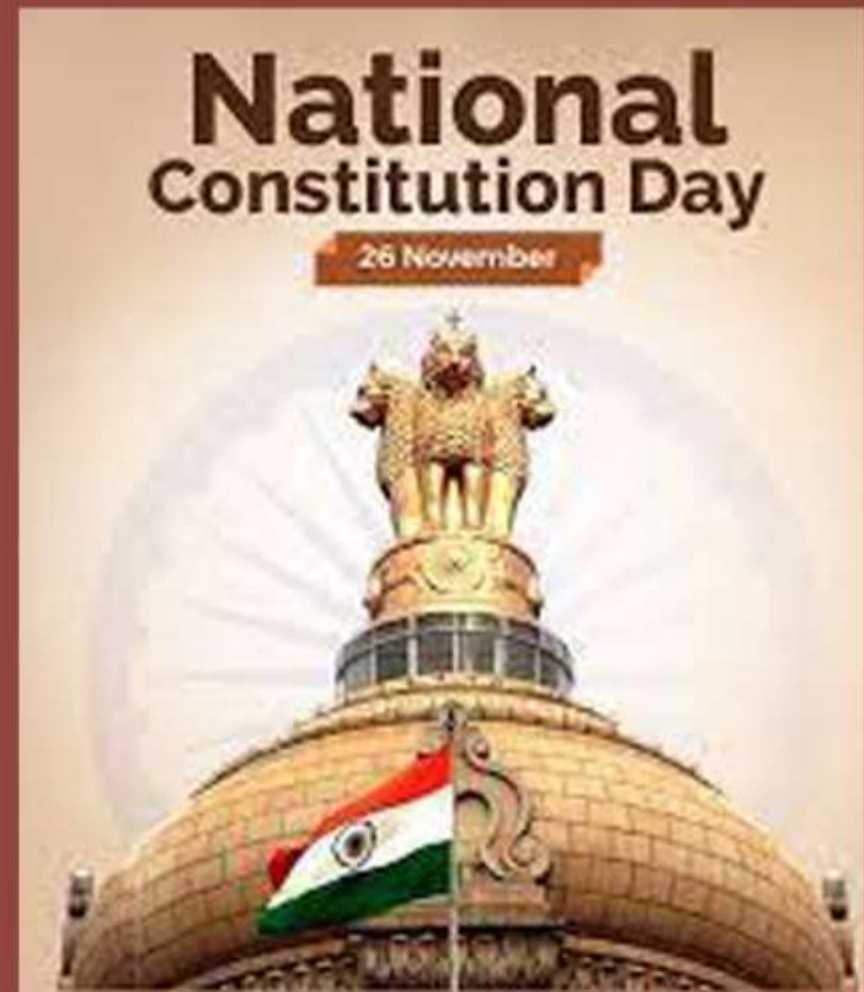
Competency Based Education

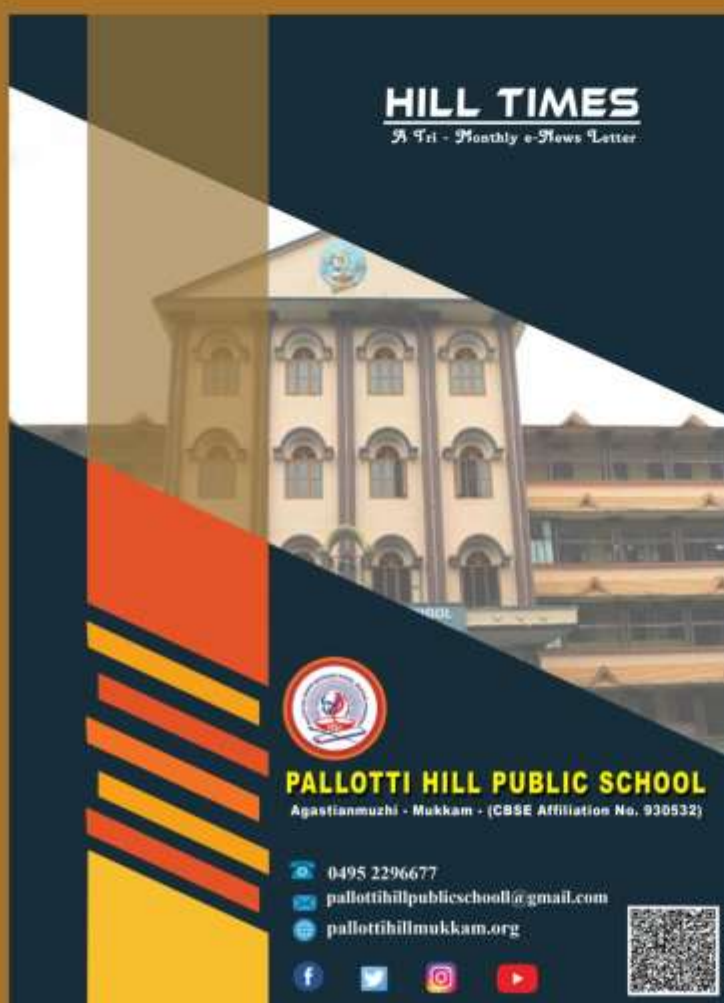
Constitution Day

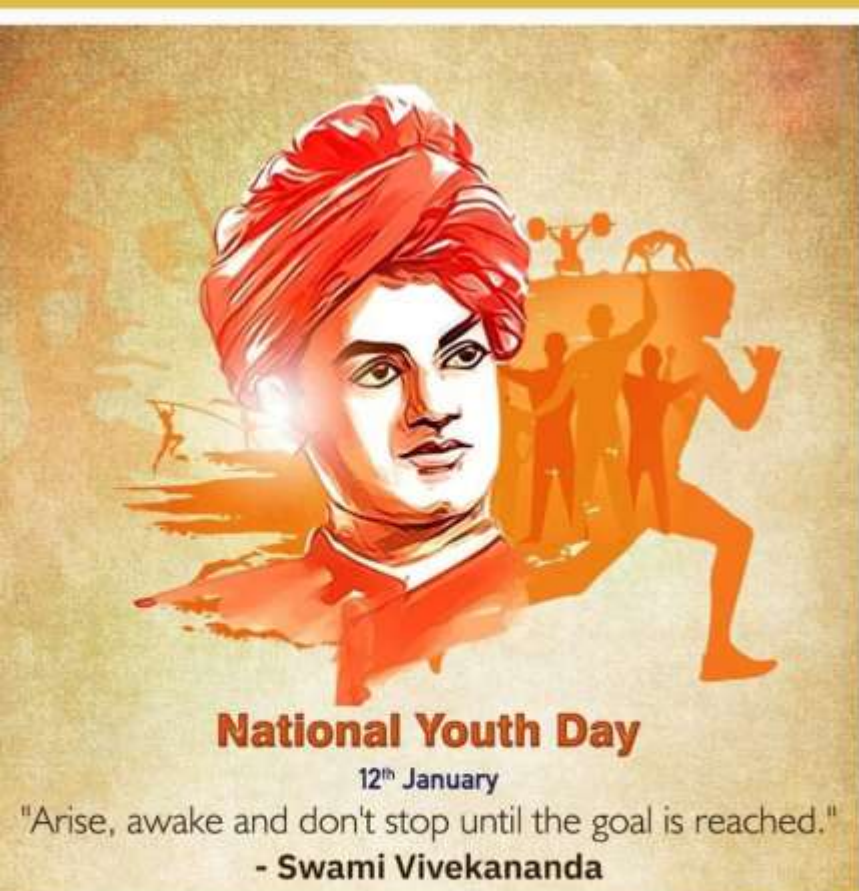
“Uskool” – A School Visit Programme

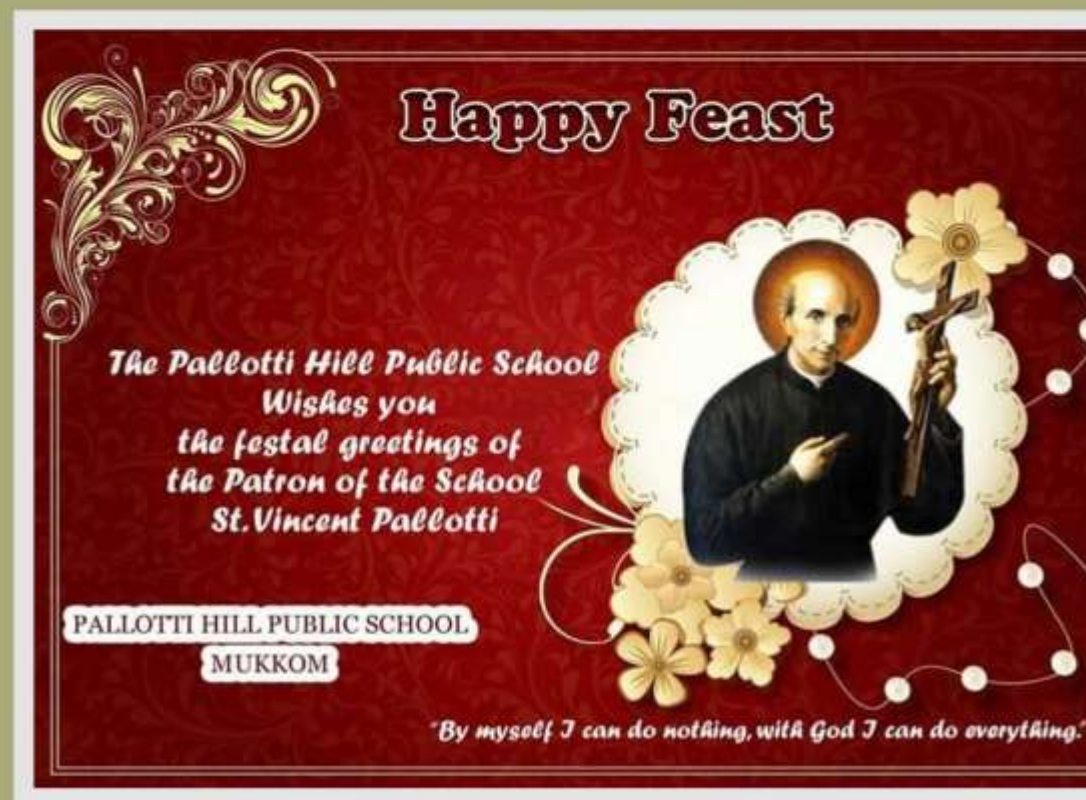
Youth Day

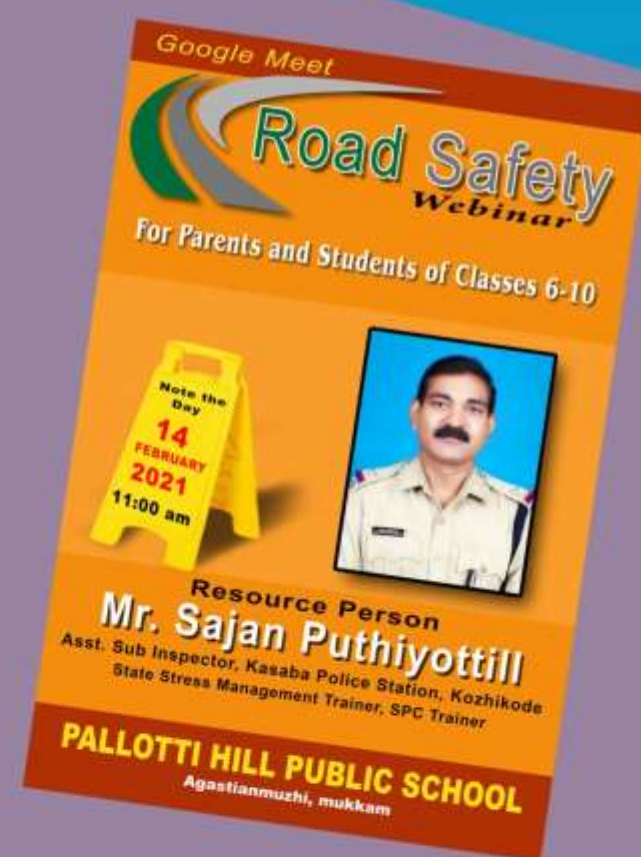
Republic Day

Road Safety Webinar



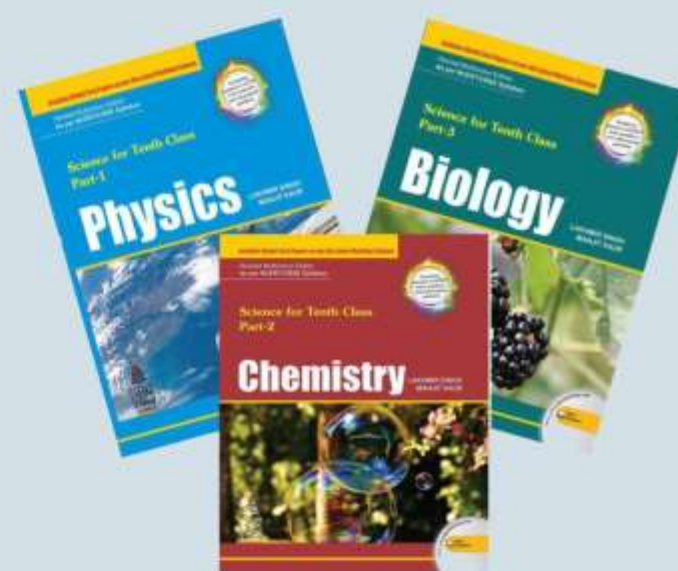
Annual Examination
